### **Description of the location**

The medical centre is in a very rural area covering nearly 500 square miles.

Grassington has 4 consulting rooms and 3 practice nurse rooms, offices and a staff room. We provide a lift to all levels, disabled toilet facilities and baby change facilities on the ground floor.

Adjacent to the building we provide adequate parking facilities which include a designated disabled bay with wheelchair access to the building from the carpark.

The surgery also provides a portable loop system for the use of deaf patients.

### **Service Users**

The practice registers patients mainly from the Grassington area and surrounding villages although a few patients are registered for medical services as out of area patients. The patient range covers the whole population.
